



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Emerald Oil Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Emerald Oil Inc compared to the market average is the variable Property, Plant and Equipment, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 102% points. The greatest weakness of Emerald Oil Inc is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 45% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 51%, being 1.0% points above the market average of 50%.
