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The relative strengths and weaknesses of Callon Petroleum Co are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Callon Petroleum Co compared to the market average is the variable Other Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 36% points. The greatest weakness of Callon Petroleum Co is the variable Other Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 23% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 110%, being 57% points above the market average of 54%.
