The relative strengths and weaknesses of Cannawake Corp are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Cannawake Corp compared to the market average is the variable Assets, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 83% points. The greatest weakness of Cannawake Corp is the variable Other Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 21% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 156%, being 102% points above the market average of 54%.
