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The relative strengths and weaknesses of Evolve Transition Infrastructure Lp are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Evolve Transition Infrastructure Lp compared to the market average is the variable Property, Plant and Equipment, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 80% points. The greatest weakness of Evolve Transition Infrastructure Lp is the variable Long-term Debt, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 55% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 65%, being 11% points above the market average of 54%.
