


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The relative strengths and weaknesses of RED Mountain Resources INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of RED Mountain Resources INC compared to the market average is the variable Oil and Gas Property, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 77% points. The greatest weakness of RED Mountain Resources INC is the variable Long-term Debt, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 38% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 61%, being 6.9% points above the market average of 54%.
