Baytex Energy USA INC Rank 44 of 171







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The relative strengths and weaknesses of Baytex Energy USA INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Baytex Energy USA INC compared to the market average is the variable Property, Plant and Equipment, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 63% points. The greatest weakness of Baytex Energy USA INC is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 36% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 135%, being 91% points above the market average of 44%.
