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The relative strengths and weaknesses of Baytex Energy USA INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Baytex Energy USA INC compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 49% points. The greatest weakness of Baytex Energy USA INC is the variable Oil and Gas Property, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 134% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -269%, being 216% points below the market average of -53%.
