



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Callon Petroleum Co are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Callon Petroleum Co compared to the market average is the variable Oil and Gas Property, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 61% points. The greatest weakness of Callon Petroleum Co is the variable Other Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 59% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 27%, being 80% points above the market average of -53%.
