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The relative strengths and weaknesses of Riley Exploration Permian Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Riley Exploration Permian Inc compared to the market average is the variable Operating Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 57% points. The greatest weakness of Riley Exploration Permian Inc is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 219% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -199%, being 146% points below the market average of -53%.
