Sandridge Energy INC Rank 114 of 140







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The relative strengths and weaknesses of Sandridge Energy INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Sandridge Energy INC compared to the market average is the variable Operating Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 33% points. The greatest weakness of Sandridge Energy INC is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 93% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -157%, being 104% points below the market average of -53%.
