



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Laredo Oil Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Laredo Oil Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 592% points. The greatest weakness of Laredo Oil Inc is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 719% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -231%, being 295% points below the market average of 63%.
