



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Daybreak OIL GAS INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Daybreak OIL GAS INC compared to the market average is the variable Other Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 24% points. The greatest weakness of Daybreak OIL GAS INC is the variable Property, Plant and Equipment, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 92% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -222%, being 293% points below the market average of 71%.
