The relative strengths and weaknesses of Denbury INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Denbury INC compared to the market average is the variable Revenue from Contract with Customer, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 55% points. The greatest weakness of Denbury INC is the variable Other Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 21% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 140%, being 51% points above the market average of 88%.
