



The relative strengths and weaknesses of AbbVie Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of AbbVie Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 85% points. The greatest weakness of AbbVie Inc. is the variable Cost of Goods Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 8.6% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 256%, being 219% points above the market average of 36%.
