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The relative strengths and weaknesses of OptiNose Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of OptiNose Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Research and Development, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 23% points. The greatest weakness of OptiNose Inc. is the variable Liabilities, Non-Current, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 114% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -48%, being 95% points below the market average of 47%.
