



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Nurix Therapeutics Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Nurix Therapeutics Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Other Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 44% points. The greatest weakness of Nurix Therapeutics Inc. is the variable Liabilities, Non-Current, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 35% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 154%, being 76% points above the market average of 78%.
