



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Trubridge Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Trubridge Inc compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 209% points. The greatest weakness of Trubridge Inc is the variable Cost of Goods and Services Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 141% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 387%, being 252% points above the market average of 135%.
