



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Sabre Corp are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Sabre Corp compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 83% points. The greatest weakness of Sabre Corp is the variable Cost of Goods and Services Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 63% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 335%, being 256% points above the market average of 79%.
