



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Everi Holdings Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Everi Holdings Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 135% points. The greatest weakness of Everi Holdings Inc is the variable Operating Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 162% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 22%, being 323% points above the market average of -301%.
