



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Applied Optoelectronics INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Applied Optoelectronics INC compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 37% points. The greatest weakness of Applied Optoelectronics INC is the variable Liabilities, Current, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 70% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 181%, being 20% points below the market average of 200%.
