Compuware CORP Rank 26 of 34

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Compuware CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Compuware CORP compared to the market average is the variable Assets, Noncurrent, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 123% points. The greatest weakness of Compuware CORP is the variable Other Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 57% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 386%, being 48% points below the market average of 435%.
