Salesforce Inc Rank 92 of 158



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Salesforce Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Salesforce Inc compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 75% points. The greatest weakness of Salesforce Inc is the variable Liabilities, Current, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 48% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 358%, being 20% points above the market average of 337%.
