



The relative strengths and weaknesses of SSI Investments II Ltd are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of SSI Investments II Ltd compared to the market average is the variable Intangible Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 104% points. The greatest weakness of SSI Investments II Ltd is the variable Long-term Debt, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 189% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 286%, being 52% points below the market average of 337%.
