





The relative strengths and weaknesses of National Instruments CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of National Instruments CORP compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 242% points. The greatest weakness of National Instruments CORP is the variable Selling and Marketing Exp., reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 18% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 521%, being 208% points above the market average of 313%.
