







Appian CORP Rank 46 of 127

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Appian CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Appian CORP compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 109% points. The greatest weakness of Appian CORP is the variable Intangible Assets, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 44% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 408%, being 76% points above the market average of 332%.
