The relative strengths and weaknesses of Intuit INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Intuit INC compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 86% points. The greatest weakness of Intuit INC is the variable Long-term Debt, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 29% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 401%, being 68% points above the market average of 333%.
