Blackberry Ltd Rank 61 of 201

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Blackberry Ltd are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Blackberry Ltd compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 120% points. The greatest weakness of Blackberry Ltd is the variable Other Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 91% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 446%, being 92% points above the market average of 354%.
