



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Oracle CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Oracle CORP compared to the market average is the variable Assets, Noncurrent, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 68% points. The greatest weakness of Oracle CORP is the variable Long-term Debt, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 230% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 212%, being 142% points below the market average of 354%.
