Blackberry Ltd Rank 83 of 156

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Blackberry Ltd are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Blackberry Ltd compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 61% points. The greatest weakness of Blackberry Ltd is the variable Liabilities, Current, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 32% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 359%, being 1.2% points above the market average of 358%.
