



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Snowflake Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Snowflake Inc compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 173% points. The greatest weakness of Snowflake Inc is the variable Intangible Assets, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 15% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 485%, being 126% points above the market average of 358%.
