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The relative strengths and weaknesses of Cerence Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Cerence Inc compared to the market average is the variable Intangible Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 160% points. The greatest weakness of Cerence Inc is the variable Long-term Debt, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 112% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 410%, being 52% points above the market average of 358%.
