



The relative strengths and weaknesses of First Western Financial Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of First Western Financial Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Liabilities, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 25% points. The greatest weakness of First Western Financial Inc is the variable Liabilities and Borrowings, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 31% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 7.6%, being 0.13% points below the market average of 7.7%.
