



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Nzch Corp are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Nzch Corp compared to the market average is the variable Other Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 1,923% points. The greatest weakness of Nzch Corp is the variable General and Administrative Expense, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 116% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 250%, being 775% points above the market average of -525%.
