Cboe Global Markets Inc Rank 14 of 30



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Cboe Global Markets Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Cboe Global Markets Inc compared to the market average is the variable Revenue from Contract with Customer, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 43% points. The greatest weakness of Cboe Global Markets Inc is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 23% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 113%, being 7.3% points below the market average of 120%.
