

Interphase CORP Rank 25 of 40

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Interphase CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Interphase CORP compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 186% points. The greatest weakness of Interphase CORP is the variable Other Net Income, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 405% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 190%, being 25% points below the market average of 215%.
