



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Silicon Graphics International Corp are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Silicon Graphics International Corp compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 174% points. The greatest weakness of Silicon Graphics International Corp is the variable Costs of Goods Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 610% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 177%, being 31% points below the market average of 209%.
