The relative strengths and weaknesses of Dell Technologies Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Dell Technologies Inc compared to the market average is the variable Administrative and Marketing Exp., increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 69% points. The greatest weakness of Dell Technologies Inc is the variable Costs of Goods Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 306% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 230%, being 28% points below the market average of 258%.
