The greatest strength of DIGI International INC compared to the market average is the variable Research and Development Exp., increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 89% points. The greatest weakness of DIGI International INC is the variable Costs of Goods Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 35% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 267%, being 26% points above the market average of 241%.
