



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Fluor CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Fluor CORP compared to the market average is the variable Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 85% points. The greatest weakness of Fluor CORP is the variable Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 70% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 134%, being 29% points above the market average of 104%.
