











The relative strengths and weaknesses of General Mills INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of General Mills INC compared to the market average is the variable Intangible Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 47% points. The greatest weakness of General Mills INC is the variable Liabilities, Long Term, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 67% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 83%, being 12% points below the market average of 95%.
