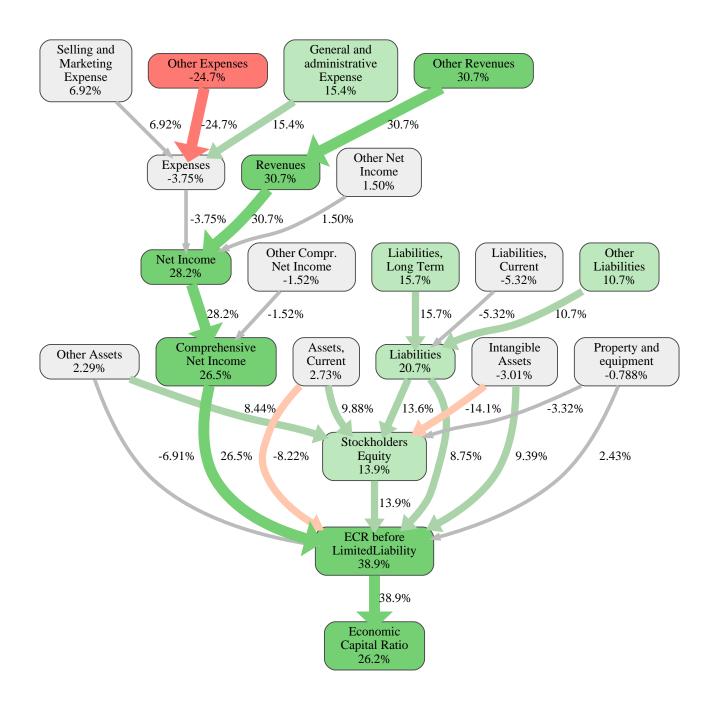

## Rocky Mountain Chocolate Factory Inc Rank 10 of 37

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Rocky Mountain Chocolate Factory Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Rocky Mountain Chocolate Factory Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 31% points. The greatest weakness of Rocky Mountain Chocolate Factory Inc is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 25% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 197%, being 26% points above the market average of 171%.
