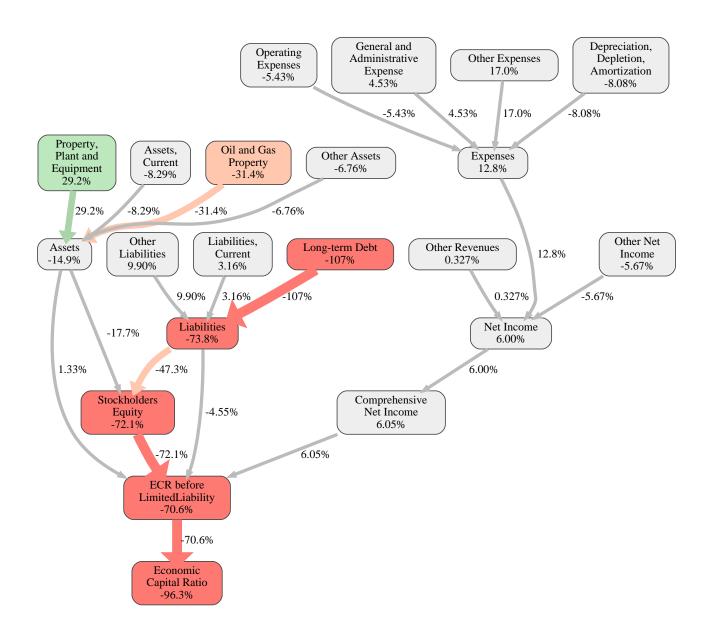

## Goodrich Petroleum CORP Rank 160 of 178

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Goodrich Petroleum CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Goodrich Petroleum CORP compared to the market average is the variable Property, Plant and Equipment, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 29% points. The greatest weakness of Goodrich Petroleum CORP is the variable Long-term Debt, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 107% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 37%, being 96% points below the market average of 133%.
