

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Evolution Petroleum CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Evolution Petroleum CORP compared to the market average is the variable Property, Plant and Equipment, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 67% points. The greatest weakness of Evolution Petroleum CORP is the variable Other Assets, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 31% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 181%, being 48% points above the market average of 133%.
