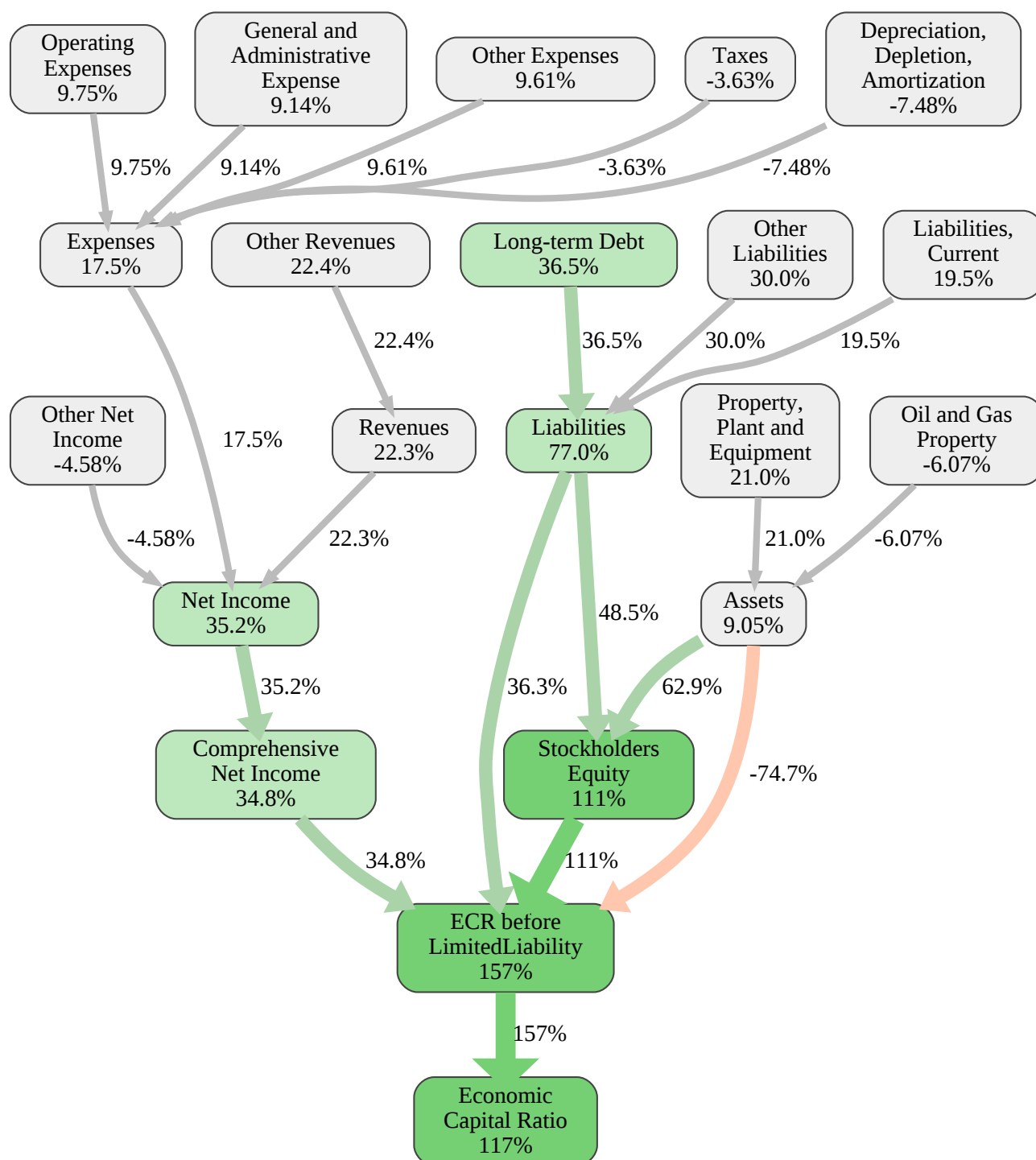




The relative strengths and weaknesses of Anadarko Petroleum CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Anadarko Petroleum CORP compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 111% points. The greatest weakness of Anadarko Petroleum CORP is the variable Depreciation, Depletion, Amortization, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 7.5% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 225%, being 117% points above the market average of 108%.
