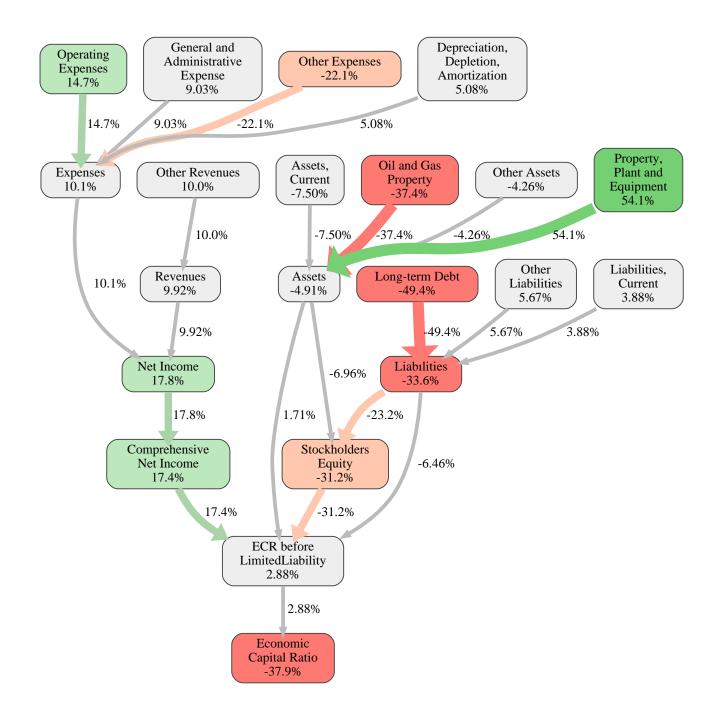

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## Expand Energy Corp Rank 104 of 191

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Expand Energy Corp are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Expand Energy Corp compared to the market average is the variable Property, Plant and Equipment, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 54% points. The greatest weakness of Expand Energy Corp is the variable Long-term Debt, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 49% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 70%, being 38% points below the market average of 108%.
