

Newfield Exploration CO DE Rank 133 of 191

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Newfield Exploration CO DE are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Newfield Exploration CO DE compared to the market average is the variable Property, Plant and Equipment, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 40% points. The greatest weakness of Newfield Exploration CO DE is the variable Long-term Debt, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 44% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 48%, being 60% points below the market average of 108%.
