




## Devon Energy CORP DE Rank 54 of 191

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Devon Energy CORP DE are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Devon Energy CORP DE compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 88% points. The greatest weakness of Devon Energy CORP DE is the variable Oil and Gas Property, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 13% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 191%, being 82% points above the market average of 108%.
