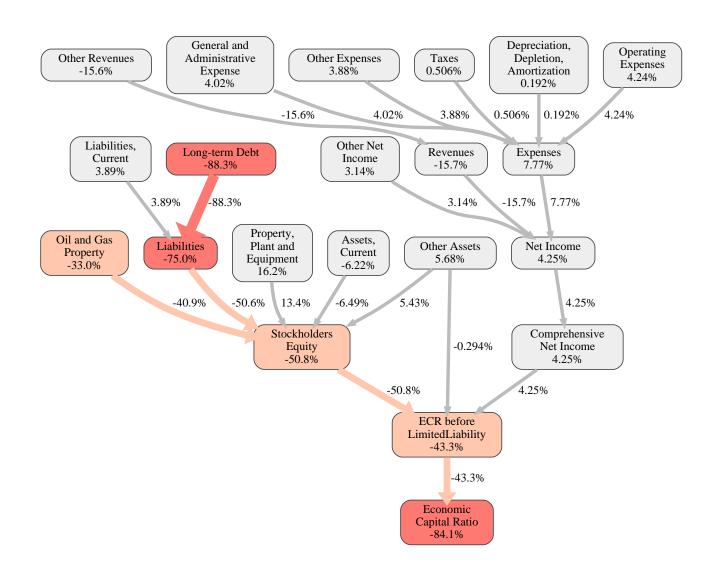


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The relative strengths and weaknesses of Endeavour International CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Endeavour International CORP compared to the market average is the variable Property, Plant and Equipment, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 16% points. The greatest weakness of Endeavour International CORP is the variable Long-term Debt, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 88% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 24%, being 84% points below the market average of 108%.
