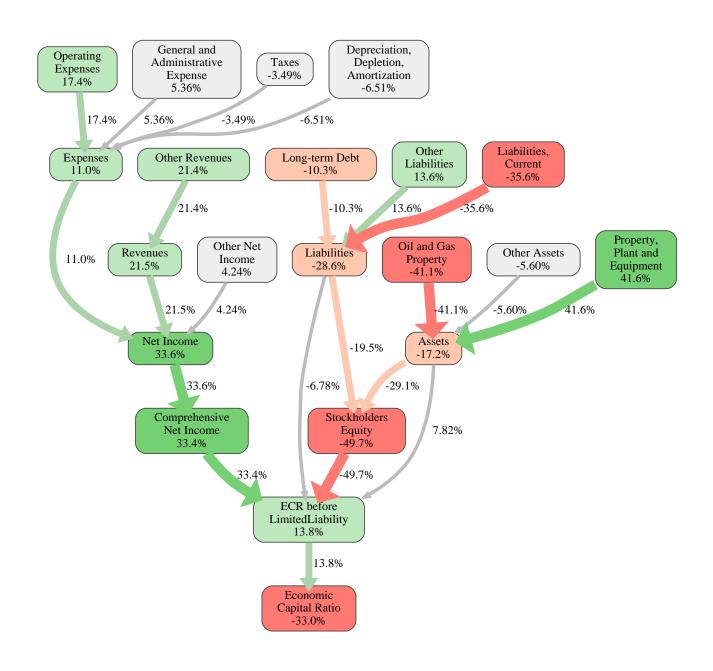

## Abraxas Petroleum CORP Rank 93 of 174

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Abraxas Petroleum CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Abraxas Petroleum CORP compared to the market average is the variable Property, Plant and Equipment, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 42% points. The greatest weakness of Abraxas Petroleum CORP is the variable Stockholders Equity, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 50% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 84%, being 33% points below the market average of 117%.
