

Range Resources CORP Rank 57 of 118





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The relative strengths and weaknesses of Range Resources CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Range Resources CORP compared to the market average is the variable Oil and Gas Property, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 56% points. The greatest weakness of Range Resources CORP is the variable Other Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 32% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 76%, being 18% points below the market average of 94%.
